

Major General John E. Standley, William Tell Johnson Inspector and  
Military Quarter Master to the 4<sup>th</sup> Division of the Militia of this State composed  
of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Brigades

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David [unclear]  
five dollars and seven and a half cents for coal furnished for the use of the [unclear]  
on your account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas [unclear]  
three dollars and fifty cents for one of Shuweis Mays and Pampblotte

Ordered that Captain Hugh Ely be authorized to have eight put to  
each of the Rifles loaned to him as may want them.

Ordered that Colonel William Standley deliver to Captain Ephraim  
Cook, forty four of the old Rifles in his possession, with the necessary accoutrements,  
for the use of the Rifle Company commanded by him. The expense of transpor-  
tation to be borne by said Cook.

Ordered that Captain Ephraim Cook be authorized to have such of  
the Rifles that have been loaned to him as want repairing to be repaired upon a  
reasonable account as he can.

By a law passed at the present Session of the Legislature, the Governor  
and Council are authorized and directed to appoint three Inspectors of Tobacco  
for the State of Maryland in the City of Baltimore, and to erect buildings suitable  
for Warehouse purposes well be secured at the Department from Customs duties  
to erect buildings of the above description until the 31<sup>st</sup> of March next.
