

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western there pay to Doctor William Howard, one of the Potomac and Baltimore Commissioners, one hundred and forty eight dollars and fifty cents, it being the amount due him for personal expenses incurred while in the execution of the duties of said appointment, allowed by a Resolution passed at the present Session, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western there pay to Colonel Abner Fenwick, one of the Potomac and Baltimore Commissioners, one hundred and forty two dollars and fifty cents, it being the amount due him for personal expenses incurred while in the execution of the duties of said appointment, allowed by a Resolution passed at the present Session, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that Jeremiah Hughes, Esquire, be employed to print the Laws and Votes and Proceedings of the General Assembly passed at December Session 1823, agreeably to the provisions of the Act of 1790, Chapter 51, Section 3, and in conformity to the 6th Resolution of the General Assembly passed at November Session 1811, and that he enter into Bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of two thousand dollars, with security, conditioned for the faithful performance of the same, allowed one thousand dollars to be paid on completion of said work.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western there pay to William Pucci, one of the Potomac and Baltimore Commissioners, fifteen dollars and fifty three cents, the balance due him for personal expenses and services as Potomac Commissioner, allowed by a Resolution passed at the present Session, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that Colonel William Starbuck, deliver to Captain William McCannon, of Frederick County, seventy five Stand of Rifles complete, for the use of the Uniform Rifle Company commanded by him. The expense of transportation to be borne by said McCannon. This order was not executed.
