

been represented to the Executive of this State by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that a certain Abraham Kerns, charged by the affidavits of Isaac W. Koser and Elizabeth Geoghegan taken before Edward D. Corfield a Justice of the Peace in and for the County of Philadelphia, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of House stealing, which affidavits have been forwarded to me duly authenticated, has fled from the Justice of the said Commonwealth and is now confined in the Jail of said County in this State, and His Excellency Andrew Shultz Governor of the said Commonwealth both in pursuance of the Constitution and Laws of the United States demanded the said Abraham Kerns as a fugitive from justice you are therefore hereby commanded to deliver the said Abraham Kerns to Mr. Smith Mills one of the Constables of the City of Philadelphia who has been duly appointed Agent to receive him and to remove him to the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania having jurisdiction of the crime wherewith he is charged, provided the said Abraham Kerns is not charged with having violated any of the Laws of this State, and provided also that the said Smith Mills do first pay and discharge all costs arising on the commitment and confinement of the said Abraham Kerns.
