ency J. Andrew Shulze, Governor of the said Commonwealth, hath in pursuance
of the Constitution and laws of the United States demanded the said William
Johnson, alias William Perry, as a fugitive from justice. You are therefore here-
by commanded to deliver the said William Johnson, alias William Perry, to
John M'Lean, high Constable of the City of Philadelphia, who has been duly ap-
pointed Agent to receive him, and to remove him to the said Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania, having jurisdiction of the offence with which he is charged -
provided the said William Johnson, alias William Perry, is not charged with having
violated any of the laws of this State, and provided also, that the said John M'Lean
do first pay and discharge all costs arising on the commitment and confine-
ment of the said William Johnson, alias William Perry - Given under my hand,
and the seal of the State of Maryland, this tenth day of March, in the year of
our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and twenty four.
