Ordered that Colonel William Mansbury deliver to Captain Hightly of Baltimore County, forty nine Cartouch Boxes for the use of the Rifle Company commanded by him provided the said Hightly do first return to the Ordnance at Annapolis the forty nine Cartouch Boxes received from him free of expense to the State.

Ordered that Thomas Hays and Beverly Johnson Esquires be appointed, to report and publish the decisions of the Board of Appeals, and that the Executives will take for the use of the State, two hundred copies of each volume at five dollars per volume, provided the same does contain five hundred pages. The Treasurer of the Western Shore is hereby directed to pay to the said Thomas Hays and Beverly Johnson Esquires, the sum of five hundred dollars to be accounted for.

Ordered that Mr. Jeremiah Hughes be employed to make three seals for the State Warehouses in the City of Baltimore.

Ordered that the Ammunition at Easton forward to the Ammunition at Annapolis forty nine Rifles.

Palmer Canfield who purchased from the Directors and Governors of St. Johns and Washington Colleges their right and interest, in and to a scheme or schemes, of a Lottery authorized by the Legislature to be drawn for the benefit of said Colleges, executed two Bonds in the penal sum of one hundred and sixty thousand dollars each, with Amos Canfield his security, to apply so much of the money arising from said Lotteries, within twelve months after the drawing of the same shall commence, as will satisfy the fortunate adventurers of prizes drawn by them, and defray the necessary expenses incurred in the management thereof; which said Bonds were approved, and ordered to be filed by the Clerk of the Council, done according to law.
