Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Gaskins two dollars for sending an Express from Easton to Governor Stevens as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw twenty one dollars and six and a quarter cents for binding Atlas & C. as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Sullivan twenty two dollars and eighteen and three quarter cents for sweeping State House and Government House Chimnies as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Hayward Esquire it being the compensation allowed him by the Executive for attending to the suits brought by the State in the Wingdam cases.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Thomas Hall Esquire was appointed Attorney General of the State of Maryland vice Thomas B. Dorsey appointed Judge and commission issued to him accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor James Thompson was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Dorchester County and a new commission issued to Arthur Rich, Thomas Breewood and James Thompson as Justices of the Orphans Court for Dorchester County.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Reverdy Johnson was appointed one of the Commissioners for ascertaining by amicable adjustment the Western and Southern Boundary lines between this State and Virginia
