The Council met present

The Council appoint Thomas Gilbreth their Clerk, who appeared and qualified as such agreeable to the Constitution and Laws of this State before Joseph Mayo one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County (as per Certificate filed) and proceeded to act.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Henry Thompson was by and with the consent of the Council appointed Prothonotary to the Court who appeared and was qualified as such agreeable to the Constitution and Laws of this State before Joseph Mayo one of the State of Maryland's Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County (as per Certificate filed) and entered upon the duties of his appointment.

By the Petition of Anthony Ricketts of Montgomery County accompanied by a transcript from the proceedings of the County Court of said County it appears that he entered into a recognizance in the sum of thirty Dollars for the appearance of one William Ricketts before the said County Court on the second Monday next November 18 24 to answer for an assault and Battery committed on the body of Gadcock Burrows, and that the said Recognizance has been forfeited.

The Petitioner states that the said William Ricketts has fled from the jail for other causes and not for this, and he avers that he was prepared to prove said William Ricketts innocent of the battery of which he was charged, he also states that he will use all exertions to obtain the attendance of the said Ricketts at the next Court. The Board do on considering the circumstances of this case and upon the recommendation of the Court and sundry respectable persons remit the said forfeiture.
