By the Petition of Jacob Lantz Lewis, F. Elliptine, John A Hoffman and John W L McMahon Delegates to the General Assembly from Allegany County it appears that at the last term of Allegany County Court in October last William Reed, William Burkitt, Robert Chesap, James Clay, John McElfish, Martin Hoffman, George North Lewis, William R Dawson, Thomas Dawson, Jacob Kottitzel, Benjamin Roberts, and Isaac Mapberry being empanelled upon a jury had retired for the purpose of agreeing upon a verdict, and after being engaged for some time returned under the impression they had all agreed, but when their foreman was in the act of announcing the verdict to the Court (it being in the recess of the Court that day) one of the Jurymen exclaimed he had not agreed, consequently there was no verdict received by the Court, and the jury for want of knowing the impropriety thereof dispersed without a further effort and then failed to agree on a verdict (it being late in the night) the consequence was a refusal was made to the Court next morning when a new jury was empanelled in the same case a fine of ~~five~~ ten Dollars each imposed upon the several Jurymen aforesaid for Contempt of the Court. They state that the parties wish a remission of the fines and for that purpose apply through them and they recommend the case as one which really deserves notice and is justly entitled to a remission. The Court upon consideration of the circumstances of the case do hereby remit the said fines.
