Ordered that the Clerk of the Council strike from the roll of military officers the name of every officer who was in commission on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1824 who has not reported himself to the Adjutant General according to the 12<sup>th</sup> section of the act entitled "A Supplement to an act entitled an act to regulate and discipline the Militia of this State" passed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1824. And that he notify the Commanders of Regiments and Extra Battalions of the names of such officers who may be stricken from the roll as the said Law directs. Provided that this order shall not be construed to extend to the Militia officers of the City of Baltimore.
