Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Rebecca Forrest or order, ninety dollars for three months pension due the first instant.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, William D Merrick Esquire was appointed Register of Wills for Charles County until the next meeting of the General Assembly. — and commissions issued to him accordingly.

Upon application being made to His Excellency the Governor stating that a certain William S Turkey is in the custody of the Sheriff of Charles County charged with having committed wilful murder upon William John Holloman and that the purposes of justice require that the trial of said Turkey should take place before the regular Session of Charles County Court. — A special Commission of Oyer & Terminer and general Goal delivery is issued and directed to John Stephen Esq Chief Judge and Edmund Key and John R Plater Esquires Associate Judges of the first Judicial district of Maryland, authorizing and requiring the said Judges to hold a Court at Port Tobacco in Charles County aforesaid, on Monday the 16th day of May next, and from thence by adjournment from day to day as may be found necessary for the trial of the said William Turkey, and all other crimes, Offences and Misdemeanors whatsoever that have arisen or may arise in the said County. — See Commission Record.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council the following Gentlemen were appointed additional Justices of the Peace for Frederick County, viz Barton Backney John M Thomas, Joseph Daniel Unkefer and William Shoney, and Lemuel W Gornel vice Isaac Wright deceased and Patrick O'Neill vice Francis Hagan deceased. — and a new Commission issued to Patrick O'Neill, Andrew Shriver, John
