

Appendix and the following orders, passed in relation thereto - Viz.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to Egidius H. Chambers Esq. six hundred and twenty seven Dollars & fifty cents, for balance and him as Commissioner to settle the Western limits of this State, & amount passed and filed.

Ordered that Colo James Boyle pay to the Treasurer of the Western Shore one hundred seventeen dollars & sixty eight & half cents, for balance of money advanced as Commissioner to settle the Western limits of this State, & amount passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to Thomas E. Liddle Esq. or order, ninety two dollars and forty cents, for balance and him as Engineer employed by the Commissioners, for settling the Western limits of this State, & amount passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry Hobbs Esq. or order, sixty two dollars and eighty cents for balance and him as a Assistant Engineer employed by the Commissioners for settling the Western limits of this State, & amount passed and filed.

Ordered that John Brewer Esq. pay to the Treasurer of the Western Shore fifteen dollars & forty four and half cents, for balance of money advanced him by Colo James Boyle some of the Commissioners to settle the Western limits of this State, & amount passed and filed.

Ordered that the Clerk, write to the Attorney General and direct him to commence suits against all Registers in Chancery, Clerks of the Court of Appeals, Clerks of the several County Courts, Registers of Wills and Clerks of the City Court of Baltimore, who have failed to record such papers as by them respectively ought to have been recorded, or who have not completed the same agreeable to the resolution, n<sup>o</sup> 14 passed at December Session 1823.
