Ordered that the Armories at Annapolis and Easton select such of the arms and  
deposited in the State House and the said Armories, as are worthy of and need repairs, and  
after ascertaining the number to report to the Clerk of the Council, who will immediately adver-  
tise for proposals for repairing them in the two newspapers at Annapolis, The Baltimore Patriot,  
American and Federal Gazette one week for three weeks.

Ordered that the respective Armories at Annapolis, Easton and Frederick Town  
clean the tents and knapsacks in their respective Armories twice a year in June and  
September Annually.

Ordered that the Walls of the Senate, House of Delegates and Executive  
Chambers and Committee rooms be yellow washed, the ceilings and stucco cornice  
be cleaned, the wood work painted, that suitable carpets be put down in the said  
Chambers and the Desks repaired in the direction of the Governor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard A. Anderson or order  
sixty dollars for one quarter half pay and the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Mansel or order  
fifteen dollars for publishing Supplement to the Militia Law, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Tuck  
or order forty seven dollars and fifty cents for boxes to pack the Laws and votes  
and proceedings, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Munro or  
order one hundred forty four dollars and half cent, for one quarter postage  
for the Executive, Treasurer and adjutant General & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Shaw or  
order fifty one dollar and seventy five cents for his amount of Stationary &c  
for the Executive department & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes  
or order four hundred and thirty dollars twenty five cents, for printing and
