

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council Thomas F. Carter and Criminal Gordon were appointed Justices of the Peace, Court of Caroline County, Vice David Capron deceased and James Langston appointed Register of Wills, and a new commission issued to Nathan Whitby, Catfield, Wright, Assessor of Taxes, William Potter, John Rumbold, Thomas F. Carter and Criminal Gordon.

Ordered that the several acts of Assembly, proposing alterations or amendments to the constitution, passed at December Session 1824, be published once a week for three weeks in the Maryland Republican and Maryland Gazette at Annapolis; The Republican Star and Gazette at Eastern; The Patriot, American and Federal Gazette at Baltimore; The Bond of Union at Belle Air; The Political Examiner at Frederick Town; The Elkton Press; The Centerville Times and the National Intelligencer.

Ordered that the armours at Annapolis, deliver to Captain Henry Thacker one set of bullet moulds.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Isaac Munro or order fifty nine dollars and fifty cents for advertising in the Baltimore Patriot by order of the Executive, and for one year subscription to his paper, if amount allowed.

Ordered that the armours at Annapolis, deliver to Captain William B. Paed thirty five pouches and powder horns.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jonas Green or order five hundred and sixty eight dollars twenty five cents for advertising in his paper by order of the Executive, and for printing sundry blank forms for the adjutant General of the State if amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James M. Keel or order fifty dollars for delivering the Laws and Votes and proceedings of December Session last to the Clerks of the several Counties upon the Eastern Shore of Contract.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Brown Esq. one hundred and eleven dollars six cents, balance of three months service as examiner General up to the 4th Instant, after deducting the amount of fees received by him, as amount passed & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson or order fifty three dollars and fifty cents to purchase firewood, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Messrs Ritchie & Gooch or order ten dollars for two year subscription to the Richmond Enquirer for the Executive, if amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Garrison Esq. fifteen dollars seventy five cents for that sum paid by him to Isaac Munro for advertising notice respecting subscription to the Penitentiary Book Loan of \$28.00. if amount allowed.
