By the Petition of William W Care, accompanied by a transcript from the proceedings of Calvert County Court, it appears that he was fined by the said Court, at October Term 1825, the sum of sixteen dollars for retarding Spirituous Liquors without Licence. The Petitioner states that he applied at the Office of the Clerk of the Clerk of Calvert County Court on the 5th day of January 1825 for a permit to retail Spirituous Liquors until the following May Court, that a young man then writing in the office told him that he was unacquainted with granting such permits, that being apprehensive of danger and having no intention to deprive the State, he commenced selling on the 6th day of January 1825 and continued to sell until the following May Term, when on the second day of the Term, he tendered the amount of his Licence at the Clerk's Office, which he always believed, and was told would be all sufficient, but the money was refused, and he was presented and fined for a violation of the Law. The Petitioner solemnly protests that the fine was imposed through misconception, and that he had no design to evade the payment of a Licence. He therefore prays for remission of the said fine. And the representation of the Petitioner relative to the application to the Deputy Clerk for a Licence being confirmed by the said Deputy Clerk, and many respectable Citizens of Calvert County aforesaid having certified the belief that the facts stated by the Petitioner are true. The said fine is hereby remitted.
