

Maryland Gazette, Annapolis; the Patriot, American, Gazette and Chronicle, Baltimore; Political Examiner, Frederick Town; Maryland Herald and Torch Light, Hagerstown; Maryland Advocate, Cumberland; True American, Rockville; Elkhorn Prop; Chester Town Telegraph; Centreville Times; Star & Gazette, Easton; Cambridge Chronicle; and Bond of Union, Harford County.

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council write to the Postmaster General and inform them that the Executive require them to renew their Bonds: believing that the Law requires them be renewed after every new appointment.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Coughlin or order one hundred and twelve dollars twenty five cents for printing blank forms for the Executive, and for advertising in his paper by them order, for amount paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order twenty nine dollars and fifty five cents for balance of his account for Stationary &c for Chancery Record, for printing the Laws and for the use of the Executive Department (after deducting \$400 advanced to him for that purpose) for amount paper and filed.

Ordered that Washington G. Tuck Super-intend the necessary repairs to stop and prevent a leak in the Roof of the State House, and the purchasing such Desks, Tables, Chairs and other furniture as may be necessary for the Chamber now occupied by the Court of Appeals - provided that the whole amount of said expensiture shall not exceed four hundred dollars.

Ordered that Washington G. Tuck cause the Ceiling of the Senate Chamber and of the House of Delegates Room to be carefully examined, and if it is found necessary to have the same repaired and put in a safe condition - And also that Jeremiah Boyd cause such repairs to be made to the top of the Dome of the State House as may be found absolutely necessary for its preservation, as provided for by Resolution of the General Assembly 1793.

On the Nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, Solomon George was appointed a Justice of the Peace of Anne Arundel County in addition to those already in Commission, and Commission issued to him, accordingly.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Nathaniel Heagy sixty Muskets and accoutrements.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Nicholas Snowden sixty Muskets and accoutrements.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Rebecca Sullivan administration of John Sullivan deceased, or order eight dollars nineteen cents for sweeping Chimneys in the State House and Government House, for amount allowed.
