Now, therefore, I Joseph Kent, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance with the aforesaid demand, to order and direct that you deliver the said Joseph Anthony alias Anthony Cavello to the said Benjamin S. Hays, agent as aforesaid; for which this shall be your sufficient warrant.

State of Maryland to wit: Whereas a certain Joseph Anthony alias Anthony Cavello, heretofore sentenced to the State Prison of the State of New York, for life, for the crime of Robbery and afterwards pardoned by His Excellency, Dewitt Clinton, Governor of that State, on condition of his forthwith departing from the United State of America and never returning to the same - Violated the condition of his said Pardon, and fled from the vessel in which he was embarked to be conveyed out of the United States, while lying in the harbour of New York, and made his escape to this State - has been ordered to be delivered to Benjamin S. Hays, agent for receiving him as a fugitive from Justice, and conveying him back to the State Prison of the said State of New York, in compliance with a demand of His Excellency the said Dewitt Clinton Governor as aforesaid. Now, therefore, all persons within the State of Maryland are hereby required and enjoined to let the said Benjamin S. Hays, agent as aforesaid, pass with the said prisoner un-molested, to the said State of New York: let the said Benjamin S. Hays conducting himself in a peaceable and orderly manner and using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.
