

Constitution; thirty six dollars for copies of the laws of last session to send to the Executives of the several States; then twenty one dollar twenty four and half cents, for contingent expenses, & amount allowed & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Jeremiah Hughes on order four hundred and thirty nine dollars eighty seven cents. viz \$352.87 for printing the laws of the last session; \$30 for making out Index, and twenty five dollars for making marginal notes to the said laws, and \$12 for packing the same in nineteen boxes and making sixty of papers, entitled to receive them, in the different Counties & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Jonas Green on order three hundred and eighty three dollars and fifty cents. viz \$3 for publishing proclamation of Election for a Representative in Congress; \$1 for publishing proposals for delivering the laws; \$48 for publishing and providing for printing schools, and \$331.50 for blank forms for the adjutant General, & amount allowed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay George Shaw on order eighty five dollars sixty eight cents, viz \$21 for binding copies of the Laws of last session to send to the Executives of the several States; \$6.31 for Stationary for recording Chancery papers, and \$57.37 for Stationary and other contingent expenses for the Executive, Treasurer, Senate, Adjutant General and Register in Chancery, & amount paid & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Grafton Monroe on order three hundred and twenty one dollars and fourteen cents for postage from the 1st of April to the 14th June for the Executive, Adjutant General and Treasurer viz for the Executive \$79.93 $\frac{1}{2}$; for the Adjutant General \$220.97 $\frac{1}{2}$; and for the Treasurer \$20.23 $\frac{1}{2}$ & amount allowed & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry Thompson on order thirteen dollars and eighty cents for commission on purchasing paper to Print the Laws, and for Daniel Hart's Bill for cutting twenty Reams of said paper, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry Hobbs on order thirty dollars seventy five cents, the amount paid by him for Bids, and Charges for Clerks appointed to Record the un-recorded Chancery papers in the Chancery office, according to a Resolution of the Legislature at the last session.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry Thompson on order one hundred and forty one dollars six cents for pay and expenses for the removal of Thomas Clow a fugitive from Justice from the State of Delaware to this State, & amount allowed & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry Thompson on order thirty eight dollars fifty cents, viz \$22 for Stationary for making Chancery Records, and \$16.50 for Stationary for the Executive, & amount
