Monday June 26 1826

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to John B Miller for "assaulting and beating Catherine Davis" and "for assaulting and beating Mary Rice" and for assaulting and beating Henry Davis: further sexual assault and Batteries the said John B Miller had been convicted by Baltimore City Court at February Term 1826. The said John B Miller being recommended to Executive Clemency by the said Court and by sundry other respectable Citizens of the City of Baltimore. (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency the Governor this day appeared in the Council Chamber and granted a Pardon to John Williams for "Felony" of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term 1826. The said John B Miller being recommended to Executive Clemency by the Jury that found him guilty, and also by the said Court. (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency also this day granted a Pardon to John Cunningham for a "Felony" of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term 1826. The said John Cunningham being recommended to Executive Clemency by the Jury that convicted him, and by sundry other respectable Citizens of the City of Baltimore. (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency the Governor this day appeared in the Council Chamber

Friday July 7 1826

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Azariah Corley for gambling of which he had been convicted by Washington County Court at Term 1826. The said Azariah Corley being recommended to Executive Clemency by sundry respectable citizens of the City of Washington, and also of Washington County aforesaid. (See Pardon Record)
