

from Justice and persons escaping from the service of their masters, &c. &c. hereby demand of the Executive authority of the said State of Virginia, the said Elijah Mone, Isaac Pickens and John W. Watson as fugitives, from the Justice of this State; and do also hereby make known to the said Executive authority, that I have appointed Henry Thompson, Member of the Executive Council, my agent to receive the said fugitives and bring them to this State, having Jurisdiction of the said offense, that they may be brought to trial therefor.

In Compliance with the requisitions of the aforesaid Act of Congress, I herewith annex and produce to your Excellency the evidence upon which this demand is founded, viz a copy from the Record of the aforesaid Court of Quarter Spring for the Borough of Norfolk, certified by, and received from, the Clerk of the said Court; and a copy of an affidavit made by John E. Tyson Esquire of the City of Baltimore on the 25th instant before Fielder Israel Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for the said City, which copy of affidavit I hereby certify is authentic.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Maryland to be affixed, at the City of Annapolis this thirty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six and of the Independence of the United States the fifty first.
