Greeting. Be it known that reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence
and integrity, we have appointed you our agent to receive from His Excellency the
Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, a certain J. G. Young alias
Wilkins, a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and to bring him from the said Common-
wealth, and deliver him to the Sheriff of Baltimore County, to answer and discharge
pending against him in Baltimore City Court.

for the public instruction of youth in primary schools; \$17 for publishing
the acts proposing alterations in the Constitution; \$3 for publishing Proclamation
of C. A. Henkle as Comptroller; \$3 for publishing Proclamation of Buckmaster
and \$3 for publishing Proclamation of Congressional Election, paid allowed.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain
Nathanial S. Hays or order sixty muskets and accoutrements.
