Governor for one quarter ending 1 January 1827. & amount allowed.

of Lottery No 8, showing a balance of \$5684.79 in favour of the
State, was submitted to the Council, and examined, approved and
passed.

S Boyd or Order eight hundred and fifty seven dollars forty nine
cents for balance due him for repairs to the Dome of the State House
(after deducting \$315 advanced him on that account) & amount allowed.
