By the petition of Jacob Lantz of Allegany County
accompanied by a transcript from the Records of the County Court
of said County, it appears that he was fined by the said Court, at
October Term 1826 the sum of one hundred dollars for a conspiracy
to defraud. The Petitioner states, that as a citizen he is willing to
submit to the decision of the constituted authorities of his Country; yet
he protests that he is innocent of the charge whereof he has been convicted;
that since the imposition of the said fine, he has been and now is in the
Sail of Allegany County; that from losses and misfortunes in trade he
is greatly embarrassed in his circumstances; that he has a mother and
five sisters, who at present are entirely dependent upon his exertions
for support; that to pay the costs which he is bound to pay, and from
which he cannot be released together with the fine is out of his power
and means; he therefore prays to be released from the said fine. And
 sundry respectable Citizens of the said County having had their belief
in the truth of the petitioners statements, and recommended a compliance
with the prayer of his petition, we do hereby remit the said fine
