

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council write to the inspectors of Tobacco at the State Warehouse, in the City of Baltimore, and require them to cause an accurate draft of the plan of a Warehouse to be erected on the premises obtained from Cumberland Dugan and they make an act of the Legislature for the Valuation and condemnation thereof, to be immediately made out, comprehending such arrangements for the inspection, safekeeping, reception and delivery of Tobacco, the transaction of the business of the Warehouse, and the security of the books, papers, accounts and other property of the Warehouse, as they shall think most necessary and convenient. That he give notice that proposals will be received, until the fifteenth day of October next, for taking down the several buildings upon the said premises and for erecting thereon a Warehouse suitable for the inspection, reception, safekeeping and delivery of Tobacco, agreeably to the laws to be passed by the inspectors as aforesaid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Beckley or order thirty five dollars for delivering the Laws and Votes and proceedings to the Clerks of the several Counties on the Eastern Shore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Amathan Pinkney Esquire, Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland or order three thousand five hundred and fifty two dollars sixty seven cents, out of the net revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco for principal and interest of a certificate of Stock held by him, being part of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse Lots. Principal - \$3025.00  
Int from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 4<sup>th</sup> September 1827 at 5<sup>ct</sup> per cent - 27.67

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Amathan Pinkney Esquire, Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland, or order, three thousand one hundred and fifty three dollars twenty one cents, out of the net proceeds of the revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco, for principal and interest of a certificate of Stock held by him, being part of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots. Principal - 3125.00, Int from 1 July to 4<sup>th</sup> Sept 1827 at 5<sup>ct</sup> per cent 28.21.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order six thousand and fifty three dollars thirty three cents, out of the net proceeds of the revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco, for part of the principal and interest thereof of a certificate of Stock held by him, for account of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots. Principal paid \$6000.00  
Int from 15<sup>th</sup> July to 4<sup>th</sup> September 1827 at 5<sup>ct</sup> per cent - 53.33

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Columbus and John Donnell or order, three thousand eight hundred and eighty three dollars nineteen cents, out of the net proceeds of the revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco, for part of the principal and interest thereof, of a certificate of Stock held by them, being part of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouse and Lots.
