

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Columbus and
Elijah Chew or Order two thousand two hundred and twenty four dollars,
forty five cents, out of the net proceeds of the revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco,
for part of principal and interest of certificate of stock held by them, the other being part
of the purchase money of Tobacco Warehouses and Lots.

dollar he has advanced on that account) Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Solomon
Etting Esquire or order three hundred and twelve dollar twenty five cents,
out of the net proceeds of the revenue arising from the inspection of Tobacco,
being for expence of the Valuation and condemnation of certain real estate in
the City of Baltimore for Tobacco Inspection Warehouses. Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay John McLeod
or order seven dollar for publishing Proclamation for the arrest of Arnold Jacobs.
Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Mary
Dickson or order three dollar and fifty cents for publishing a proclamation
for the arrest of L Griffith and W Harris, and an advertisement for the
arrest of the same persons by the Sheriff. Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry
Thompson or order one hundred and eighty four dollar seventy three cents, balance
due him for delivering weighty and measures to the Levys Courts of the several
Counties and for delivering Harris & Kingsley Reports and Mettles Inroad to
the Levys of the several Counties (after deducting two hundred and fifty
dollar advanced him on that account) Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Galey
Seaton or order two hundred dollar thirty seven & half cents, viz \$7.87 1/2 for
publishing a Proclamation for the arrest of Arnold Jacobs, and \$4.50 for
publishing the Regulator of Lawson as Insurer. Payment allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Henry
Thompson or order thirty nine dollar sixty cents for Stationary for recording
various papers, under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions
of the General Assembly. Payment allowed.
