

September the 17th 1827

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to James Dunlop alias James Evans, on account of having offered to pay a forged check of Henry Clarke for the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars at the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Baltimore of which he was convicted in Harford County Court at August Term last, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for three years. — (See Pardon Record).

October 2nd 1827.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridgely or order fifty six dollars twenty five cents for one quarter salary as Librarian due the first Instant. —

October 4th 1827.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James A Buchanan or order five hundred dollars for one quarter Rent of Calhouns House inspection Warehouse, due the first Instant. —

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Kibby Esquire or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the first Instant. —

October 5th 1827.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mrs. Anne Leache or order eighty dollars for six months pension, due the first Instant. —
