The Council met, agreeably to public notice.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Gideon Pearce six hundred or over one hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Otho Scott six hundred and twenty five dollars for three quarters salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Stewart six hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Daniel Martin six hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Moses Sheppard or order two hundred and twenty dollars fifty Cents, for one quarter interest upon a certificate of stock held by him for the purchase of money of Tobias Warhorne and Lot, up to the first instant.
