Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown or Bearer or order one hundred and sixty one dollar sixty six cents for balance of a quarterly salary as Examiner General due the first instant, (after deducting the amounts of fees received) for account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William C. Beall or order two hundred and sixty dollar forty cents for recording Chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Isaac King or order two hundred and fifty seven dollar twenty two cents for recording Chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Hobbs or order five hundred and three dollar twelve cents for recording Chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Brown or order one hundred and eighty nine dollar for recording Chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph Mayd or order three hundred and fifty eight dollar for recording Chancery papers under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Culbreth or order three hundred and ninety one dollar ninety three cents for superintending the recording of Chancery papers, under contract with the Executive, by virtue of Resolutions of the General Assembly.
