And whereas I am desirous, for the reasons hereafter expressed, further to extend the time for the execution of the said Negro James Cruxton in a law, therefore, I Joseph Kent Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby further suspend the execution of the said Negro James Cruxton until Friday the eleventh day of April next, on which day, or before twelve o'clock you are hereby desired to execute the said Negro James Cruxton, if he shall be directed by my Warrant, unless you shall hereafter be thereunto moved by lawful authority.
