

The Lottery Commissioning Account of State Lottery No 1 for 1828. Showing a balance of six hundred and twenty two dollars eighty one cents in favour of the State, was this day laid before the board and examined, approved and passed.

Ordered that on or after the tenth day of August next, the Clerk of the Council draw on the Treasurer of the Western Shore in favour of Lawson Newman for such sum of money, clear of all charges, as may be in the Treasury, arising from the inspection of Tobacco.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Stewart fifty or order two hundred and fifty dollars for six months salary as a member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Rezin Estep or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William B Jackson or order eleven dollars fifty and half cents for postage for the Governor up to the first Instant, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Grafton Munro or order three hundred and six dollars fifty seven cents for postage for the Executive, Adjutant General and Treasurer up to the 20th of June, viz for the Executive \$12.50 for the Adjutant General \$101.17 1/2 and for the Treasurer \$12.83, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Moppy Gale Boatman or order thirty dollars for one copy of the Daily National Intelligencer from the 6th of March 1828 to the 6th of March 1829, and for another copy from the first of January 1827 to the first of January 1829, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McNeir or order four dollars for one year subscription to the Carrolltonian from the 20th of September 1827 to the 20th September 1828, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Puck or order six hundred and twenty seven dollars eighty nine cents for sundry repairs to the State and Government House, and to the State House Pump, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Puck or order two hundred and twenty dollars seventy five cents, viz \$199 for repairing and cleaning Arms, \$8.50 for firing Salutes 4th July, \$12.50 for one quarter salary for taking care of the public property, up to the 20th Instant, 25 cents for one year
