

Command of His Excellency Andrew Shultz Governor of the State of

the Executive Department of this State, that the said James Wilson, having charged
by indictment of a Grand Jury with fornication and bastardy, alleged to have
been committed in the County of Adams in the said State. - And therefore, I
Joseph Kent Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and enjoin
all persons within this State, to let the said James Bowen agent as aforesaid
pass with the said fugitive unobscured to the said State of Pennsylvania: he
the said James Bowen agent as aforesaid, conducting himself in a peaceable
and orderly manner, and using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment
of the said prisoner.
