

The Atty Commrs account of State Storage, no 2 for 1128, showing a balance of one hundred and seventy two dollars ten cts, in favour of the State, was this day laid before the board and examined, approved and paid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Fletcher or order four hundred dollars in account of wages for Captain Ballard, and Lieutenants Mayo and Casp, under Resolutions of the General Assembly, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Shaw & Guse or order twenty three dollars seventy five cts, viz \$3.12 1/2 for Stationary for recording Chancery papers, and \$21.62 1/2 for Stationary for the comptrol general's Auditor, and sundry contingent expenses of the Executive, \$ amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Tick or order forty six dollars thirty nine cts, for Lock and sundry repairs to the State House and other public property, \$ amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Rothrock or order twenty one dollar thirty five cts, for repairs of John's Inspection Warehouse, \$ amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Rachel Moore or order eighteen dollars thirty three cts, for sundry Smiths work for repairs to the State House, \$ amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John M. Whittington or order eight dollars, viz \$5 for binding books in the Library, under Resolution of the last General Assembly, and \$3 for binding Laws of the last Session for distribution to the several States, and for the Library, by order of the Executive, \$ amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Davis or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council, due the first day of July last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Lawson Newnan or order two thousand five hundred dollars, as account of building Warehouse for the Inspection of Tobacco, to be accounted for.
