Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jonas Green or order thirteen dollars viz \$4.00 for Loans for the Treasurer, \$5 for Printing & Land Certificates for the Register of the Land Office and \$3 for the Maryland Gazette for 1828, & Account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Grafton Munroe or order sixty nine dollars sixty seven cents viz \$65.67 for one quarter postage for the Executive, \$6.73 for ditto for the adjutant General, and \$17.52 1/2 for ditto for the Treasurer, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Arnold E. Jones or order ten dollars eighty seven and half cents for expence of carrying Samuel Adams a deaf and dumb boy to the Pennsylvania Institution & Account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridgely or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Librarian due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edmund and Mallice or order four dollars and fifty cents for washing and putting new sills and putting windows in the Council Chamber, & Account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown of Benjamin or order one hundred and fifty three dollars fifty six cents for balance due him for one quarter salary as Examiner General, (after deducting the amount of fees received) due the first Instant, & Account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Thompson or order twenty six dollars eighty four cents viz \$26.84 for Stationary for the Executive and \$4 cents for freight on Map of Virginia and a Card Room, & Account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Stewart or order two hundred and fifty dollars for six months salary as member of the Council due the first Instant.
