

March 1. 1830.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Shaw and Leland, four dollars twelve & a half Cents, of stationery furnished the Auditor General in September 1828.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Dennis Leland J<sup>r</sup> V<sup>o</sup>: Three dollars thirty one and a half cents: viz: For State Library 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  Cts. for Executive \$1.69. & for the Adjutant General \$1.50, as per Account allowed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Dennis Leland J<sup>r</sup> V<sup>o</sup>: Fifteen dollars, seventy three Cents. viz: for the Adjutant General \$1.71. for repairs of State House \$2.20 for the Executive \$11.82, - as per Account allowed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of the Baltimore Equitable Society, forty eight dollars sixty five Cents, for the State's proportion of the Contribution to make good the State loss sustained by fire in D. T. Thomas's sugar refinery and other late losses.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Thomas King Carroll, Governor of Maryland, Three dollars seventy five Cents, it being the amount paid by him for sweeping chimneys at the Government house.

March 4. 1830.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Richard Wells, Steward at the Government House, Thirty five dollars for two months & three days salary to 3<sup>rd</sup> inst<sup>l</sup> inclusive.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Joseph Sands J<sup>r</sup> Two dollars, for Freight on a box of books from Boston for the Executive.

March 5<sup>th</sup>. 1830.

Ordered, that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of George Brewer, Register of the Land Office, Three dollars for his allowance, under the act of May 27<sup>th</sup> 1813, ch. 6, § 8. providing to the Commissioners of the tax, a list of all the unimproved tracts of Land ready for patents, for the year 1829. -
