

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of James Murray Clerk of the Council, Two Hundred and fifty dollars for two months salary to 1<sup>st</sup> inst.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Jonas Green (postmaster at Annapolis) One Hundred and forty three dollars twenty seven Cents, due 1<sup>st</sup> inst. viz. \$133.07 for the Executive, \$8.09 for the Treasurer, & \$2.09 for State Library. →

April 10<sup>th</sup> 1830.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of William Hollingsworth, Justice for Robert Hollingsworth, Thely seven dollars fifty Cents, for One quarter Interest on \$3000. of State 5 per Cent Tobacco Inspection Loan, due 1<sup>st</sup> inst. and payable by Endorsement to Samuel Maynard Cash.

April 12<sup>th</sup>.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Mrs Anne Leache, Forty dollars for one quarter pension due her by act of November Session 1785.  
Commission issued to Edward Quinn as Auctioneer for the City of Baltimore.

April 19.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Mrs. Rebecca Forrest, One Hundred and eighty dol. for six months pension due her by Resolution passed at October Session 1780.

His Excell. the Governor this day granted a pardon to James Foster, convicted at April Term 1830, in Cecil County Court of Manslaughter. (See pardon record)

April 22<sup>nd</sup>.

His Excell. the Governor, this day granted a pardon to Abraham Poteb, convicted by Baltimore City Court in 1825, of "Larceny", and sentenced to five years confinement in the Penitentiary. (See pardon record)

April 23<sup>rd</sup>

His Excell. the Governor this day granted a pardon to Dineen Miller, convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term 1829, of assaulting and beating Caroline Ford. (See pardon record)
