

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of the Hon. Hugh, McEldery, four dollars, for so much paid by him, for a pen Cutter for the use of the Executive.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Jeremiah Hughes, thirty two dollars thirty seven and a half cents, for publishing the Laws for the preservation of shell fish, and for articles furnished for the use of the Executive, as per acct allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Jeremiah Hughes, One thousand, nine hundred and forty three dollars, and fifteen cents, for public printing done for both branches of the Legislature, by contract with the Joint Com-mittee of both branches of the Legislature at Dec^r. Term 1829.

The proposals of William P. Tate to deliver the Laws and Votes, and proceedings of both branches of the Legislature, and Harris and Gill's Reports, to the County Clerks of the Western Shore, for One hundred and ten dollars; and of Robert, B. A. Tate, to deliver the same on the Eastern Shore, ^{for Eighty four dollars,} having been submitted, to the Executive, among others, were approved, and the penalty of Three thousand dollars prescribed for their safe delivery on the Western Shore, and the penalty of Two thousand dollars for the Eastern Shore.

By the petition of George Griffith of Harford County it appears, that he was fined by Harford County Court at March Term 1830, for selling merchandize without licence, in the sum of fifty dollars, and costs: - The petitioner states that he has been trading as a merchant for many years in said County, and has regularly taken out licence to the fourth of October 1828: and that after the change in the law regulating licences, he went to the Clerk's office for the purpose of complying with its provisions, and was informed that it was unnecessary: that he had no intention to evade the law of 1828, or to defraud the State: and the said Griffith being recommended to the Executive for a remission of said fine by the Judges of Harford County Court, are so hereby remit the same.
