

Morrison dated the third day of April 1830 in the penalty of eighteen hundred dollars, for safe keeping and delivery of sixty five muskets, and accoutrements, was examined and approved.

The account of Nathaniel Mitchell, Editor of the Chester Town Telegraph amounting to twenty seven dollars, for publishing the Laws for the improvement of Oysters, and preservation of shell fish, was examined and passed.

Ordered that the clerk of the Council be authorized to purchase of Jonas Green of Annapolis, the proceedings of both Branches of the Legislature of this State, provided the cost does not exceed the sum of three hundred dollars.

Upon the representation of many respectable Citizens of the City of Baltimore, William Fox of the City of Baltimore, was selected to be sent to the Asylum for the deaf and dumb in the City of Philadelphia.

The account of George Keatinge Editor of the Snow Hill Messenger amounting to thirty dollars, for publishing the Laws for the preservation of Oysters, and the improvement of shell fish was examined and passed.

The account of Alexander Graham Editor of the Easton Gazette amounting to fifteen dollars, was examined and passed.

The following demand was this day made upon the Governor of Pennsylvania, upon the application of Richard W. Gill, Deputy Attorney General for Baltimore County. - viz.

To His Excellency George Wolf
Governor of the State of Pennsylvania.

Whereas Abraham Potest, and George Wilson have been convicted by Baltimore City Court of an assault with intent to kill a certain Deputy Keeper of the Penitentiary of this State: and whereas it is known to this Department, that the said Abraham Potest and George Wilson have fled from Justice, and are at this time in the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania: and it being of great importance to the good of society that the perpetrators of heinous crimes of this description be brought to Justice. I have therefore thought proper by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the United States, to demand, and I do hereby demand the said Abraham Potest, and George Wilson, as fugitives from the State of this State, and I hereby make known to your Excellency
