

May. 4th 1830.

This Evening the Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to William Hilly of Anne Arundel County, for an assault and battery, on Thomas Gardner, and James Taylor, for which he was indicted at April Term 1820 of Anne Arundel County Court. (see pardon record) >

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Charles Carroll, (of Carrollton) One Hundred and one dollars, seventy seven and p^{ts} cents for six months Interest on \$4071. of State 5 p^{ts} C^{ts} Tobacco Inspection Loan, due 1st ulto.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of William McNeir, Twenty two dollars, for publishing laws for Improvement of Shell Fish & preservation of oysters.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of John W. Whittington, Four dollars, seventy five cents for binding nineteen copies of the acts of Assembly for the use of the County Clerks. >

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of the Hon. Robert S. D. B. Wright, a member of the Executive Council, One Hundred and twenty five dollars, for One quarters salary to 1st ulto. >

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Jonas Green, Three hundred and sixty one dollars & fifty cents. viz. \$20.50. for printing for the Execution, \$21. for publishing Laws for Improvement of Oysters and preservation of Shell Fish, and \$320. for blanks for the Adjutant General.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Daniel Hart, sixteen dollars for a Blank Record Book for the use of the Executive. >

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Jonas Green, Three Hundred dollars, for the Votes and proceedings of the Conventions held antecedently to the formation of the State Government, as also for the Votes and Proceedings of both branches of the Legislature, purchased by the Executive under an act of the Legislature passed at December Session 1825 ch. 78.
