

June 25th 1830.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Nathaniel Harman, Adm^r cum testamento annexo, of Lazarus Harman, Twenty eight dollars, sixty six & 4/10 Cents, it being the amount due said Lazarus Harman a Revolutionary Pensioner, for eight months, eighteen days pension to 18. July 1829, the day of his death.

June 26.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Gideon Pearce, Contractor for the delivery of the laws, votes and proceedings of December Session 1829, to the Clerks of the several Counties in this State, Eighty four dollars on account.

June 29.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a pardon to Henry Queen (negro) convicted in Baltimore City Court at June Term 1830 of petit Larceny. (see pardon record)

July 1.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Gideon Pearce, Seventy five dollars, for one quarter salary as chief Clerk of the House of Delegates.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to the order of William Brown Esq (of Dan) Examining General of the Western Shore One Hundred & fifty nine dollars, fifty three Cents, it being the balance due him for one quarter salary to this date, after deducting the amount of fees received by him.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of David Ridgely Librarian to the State, One Hundred & twenty five dollars, for one quarter salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of His Excellency Thomas King Baudin, Governor, six hundred & sixty six dollars, sixty six Cents, for One quarter Salary due this day. Payable by Endorsement to Paul Alley Esq Cashr.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Lewis Nett, sixty four dollars, twenty five cents, for six months interest on \$2570. of State Live Tobacco Inspectors due this day.
