

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Lewis Fajaway, Chief Clerk to the Senate, Thirty seven dollars & fifty cents for one quarters salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Gordon Pearce, One hundred dollars the balance due on his Contract for delivering the Laws, votes & Proceedings &c of both Branches of the Legislature, for December Session 1829, to the respective County Clerks, whose receipts for the same, he delivered in this Office.
