

The following demand was made on the Governor of Pennsylvania.
To His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania.

Whereas a certain John W. King yeoman of the City of Baltimore, (alias) John W. Crawford, (alias) John W. Roberts, stands charged by indictment of the grand Jury for the body of the City of Baltimore, with grand Larceny;— And whereas information has been received at the Executive Department, of this State, that the said John W. King, alias John W. Crawford, alias John W. Roberts has fled from Justice, and is now in the City of Philadelphia.

And it being important and highly necessary for the good of Society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to justice; Now therefore I, Thomas King Carroll, Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested in me, by the Constitution and laws of the United States, do hereby demand the said John W. King, alias John W. Crawford, alias John W. Roberts as a fugitive from the justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed George Riggs and James, H. Jeffers my Agents to receive the said fugitive, and bring him to this State, having jurisdiction of the said offence, that he may be brought to trial therefor.

In compliance with the requisitions of the law, I herewith annex and produce to your Excellency, a copy of the Indictment upon which the demand is founded; which I certify is authentic.

Greeting We it know that reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence and honesty, I, Thomas King Carroll Governor of the State of Maryland, have appointed you my Agents to receive from His Excellency, the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, a certain John W. King, alias John W. Crawford, alias John W. Roberts, charged by the indictment of the Grand Jury of the City of Baltimore, with certain crimes therein stated: a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and I do hereby authorize and direct you, upon receiving the said fugitive to bring him into this State, and convey and deliver him, to the Sheriff of Baltimore County, to answer for having on the fifteenth day of June in the year One thousand eight hundred and thirty, with force and arms at the City aforesaid feloniously
