Upon the application of His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the  
State of Pennsylvania, the following writs and warrant were issued vizt  
The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of any County in the State Dreeting

Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and trans-  
mitted to this Department by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of  
the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain R. Dillow Drake late of  
the City of Philadelphia, stands charged on three Indictments by the  
grand Jury of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, enquiring for the City  
of Philadelphia, with certain crimes therein stated to have been com-  
mitted in the said City, and that the said R. Dillow Drake has fled  
from the Justice of the said State, and is now residing in the State  
of Maryland. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as  
aforesaid, hath in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by  
the Constitution and laws of the United States, demanded the said R.  
Dillow Drake of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from  
Justice and appointed Augustus Newlow his agent to receive the  
said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania  
for trial for the said offence. Now therefore J. Thomas King  
Carroll, Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper  
in compliance with said demand to order and direct the surrender  
of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct, that you  
forthwith arrest and deliver the said R. Dillow Drake, if he  
is to be found in your bailiwicks to the said Augustus Newlow  
agent as aforesaid: he the said agent first paying all costs  
of the said arrest and detention of the said fugitive: for all which  
shall be your sufficient warrants.
