

The State of Maryland, to wit. >

Whereas in compliance with a demand of the  
-cellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, orders  
have been given for the surrender of a certain R. Dillow Drake  
as a fugitive from the justice of the said state, to Augustus  
Newton agent duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and  
transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania, it appearing  
from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department  
of this state, that the said R. Dillow Drake, stands charged by  
the grand Jury of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, enquiring for  
the City of Philadelphia, with certain crimes therein stated, to  
have been committed in said City.

Now therefore I Thomas King Carroll Governor of  
the State of Maryland, do hereby require and enjoin all  
persons within this State, to let the said Augustus Newton  
agent as aforesaid pass with the said fugitive, unmolested to  
the said State of Pennsylvania, let the said agent conducting  
himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improp-  
-er severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

hundred and thirty, and of the Independence of  
the United States the fifty fifth. >

By the petition of Theodor, B. Deany (negro), accompanied by a  
transcript from the record, it appears that he was fined in the sum of  
five dollars & costs at Baltimore City Court & term for Terms 1829.  
for assaulting and beating Frederick Townsend, and prays a remis-  
-sion of the same.

The petition states, that his conviction was owing to  
the exclusion made by the laws of the testimony of white persons of his  
own colour, none other being present: that he is very poor and  
has a large family dependent on him for support, who are now  
in a state of great suffering; His case is also recommended  
to the consideration of the Executive by many respectable  
gentlemen of Baltimore. On consideration of the circum-  
-stances we do therefore remit the fine. >
