His Excellency the Governor this day was the following demand on the Governor of Pennsylvania. >

To His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania. >

Whereas a certain Samuel Green of the City of Baltimore, stands charged by Samuel, Jr. Milliron and Thomas B. Edwards two of the peace Officers of the said City, with having goods in his House which they have reason to believe were stolen from different persons, and that some of the said goods have already been proven to have been stolen. >

And whereas information has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that the said Samuel Green has fled from Justice and is now in the State of Pennsylvania. > And it being important and highly necessary for the good of society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to Justice. Now therefore I Thomas King Barlow Governor of the State of Maryland by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States do hereby demand the said Samuel Green, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed James H. Jeffers and George Regis my agents to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having jurisdiction of the said offence, that may be brought to trial therefor. >
