him into this State, and convey and deliver him to the proper
authority.

The returns of the Judges of the Election of Sheriffs in the various
counties of the State having been received and examined were found
to be correct & commissions ordered to be issued which was accom-
plished accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Show, pay to the order
of James H. Jeffery and George Riggs, One hundred and three dollars
for expenses and compensation in going to Pennsylvania by order of
the Executive, for Samuel Green a fugitive from Justice.

By the petition of Christian Winter of Washington County accom-
panied by a transcript from the record, it appears that at March Term
1830 of Washington County Court, he was fined by said Court the sum
of fifty dollars for selling spirituous liquor without license.

The petitioner states, on the 14th May 1829, he purchased from
Augustus Sellman of Washington County a Confectionary and Oyster estab-
lishment, for which he paid said Sellman and also for the amount for
which the said Sellman had paid for License, having been assured
by said Sellman that a transfer of his license to him would be a
sufficient compliance with the Law. That being a foreigner and
ignorant of the Law he believed the said assurances, and was in-
consequently fined by the Court, that he had no intention to defraud
the State, having taken out a new License as soon as he knew it to
be necessary. He therefore prays a remission of the fine which being
recommended by one of the Judges of the County Court is hereby
