

Clark, convicted in Indictment in Baltimore City Court at November Term 18 of stealing a broad axe. (See pardon record.)

December 8th 1830.

His Excellency, The Governor this day commuted the punishment of hairless convicted at October Term 1830 of murder in the first degree, to five years confinement at hard labour in the Penitentiary, from the date of her conviction in lieu of being hanged by the neck until she be dead. (See pardon record.)

Upon the surrender this day by Susannah Veazy of a Certificate for \$1500, of State 5th V. C. Tobacco Inspection Loan, in the name of James and Alexander Heron, the said Certificate was cancelled and a new Certificate issued for \$1500 in the name of said Susannah Veazy, to bear interest from the first day of October last.

December 10th 1830

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Nelson Nichols, Steward at the Government House, sixty two dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary due the 3rd inst.

December 17th

His Excellency, The Governor this day granted a pardon to James Scott, convicted in Indictment in Washington County Court at November Term 1830, of Petit Larceny. (See pardon record.)

December 21. 1830.

His Excellency, The Governor this day granted a pardon to Thomas Meek, convicted at October Term 1830 of Anne Arundel County Court of stealing wood, and sentenced to two years confinement in the Penitentiary. (See pardon record.)

December 27.

The Executive met, agreeably to adjournment.

His Excellency, The Governor this day granted a full Pardon to Warren D. Watson presented at August Term 1829 of Charles County by the grand Jury for the body of said County for harbouring negro, and a slave the property of William Tubman. (See pardon record.)

His Excellency, The Governor also this day granted a pardon to Stephen Johnson (negro), convicted on Indictment in Baltimore City Court at November Term 1830, of stealing twenty five pounds of goods of the value of three dollars. (See pardon record.)
