I do know that exposing great trust and confidence
in you pursued me honesty, I James H. Lane, Governor
of the State of Maryland have appointed you my Agent
to accuse for the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania,
John Charles Scott, Robert Drueby and Lewis Hool
tredebs fugitives from the justice of this State; and I
do hereby encharge and direct you upon receiving the said
fugitives to bring them into this State and convey and deliver
them to the keeper of Baltimore County Jail to answer for
the crimes alleged against them by the presentments of the
grand Jury of the City of Baltimore.

Given under my hand on the first seal of the
State of Maryland this fifth day of Decem-
ber in the year of our Lord One thousand and eight
hundred and thirty one of the Independence of the United
States, the fifty fifth.
