

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of George Keatinge, Editor of the Snow Hill Messenger sixteen dollars for publishing laws for preservation of Oysters, and improvement of shell fish as per his account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of John Johnson & Richard W. Hill, One thousand dollars for Two Hundred Copies of the first volume of Hill & Johnsons Reports, deposited in the State Library, as per the Libarians receipt, dated 17 December 1830.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of James Jeffers and George Riggs, Two Hundred & forty two dollars eleven & a half Cents, for expenses and compensation in bringing Robert Crosby, Lewis Holtenbach, and John Dant fugitives from justice, from Philadelphia to Baltimore, by the Governors demand as per their account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of Daniel Hoar, thirteen dollars fifty Cents; viz for binding for State Library \$12.50, and \$1.00 for tumblers for the Judges of the Court of Appeals.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Jonas Green, nineteen dollars, viz: for publishing laws proposing to alter the Constitution paper at December Session 1829, \$15. for advertising for proposals for printing \$1.00, and for subscription to the Maryland Gazette for 1830, \$3.00.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Nathaniel Mitchels Editor of the Chester Town Telegraph thirteen dollars for publishing Laws proposing to change the Constitution paper at December Session 1829.
