December 31. 1830.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of the Hon: John Forman a member of the Executive Council Two hundred and thirty dollars, fifty six Cents, for his salary from 14th July to 1st January 1831.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of David Ridgely Librarian to the State, One hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarters salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of His Excellency Thomas King Carroll, Governor, six hundred and sixty six dollars, and sixty six Cents, for one quarters salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of Jonathan Hutton, Armorer at Annapolis, One hundred and thirty seven dollars fifty Cents, viz \$125. for one quarters salary as Armorer, and \$12.50 for taking care of the public property, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Gideon Peard Chief Clerk to the House of Delegates, seventy five dollars, for one quarters salary due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore, pay to the order of Mary Runsey daughter of Henry C, seventeen dollars fifty Cents, for one quarters interest due this day on \$1400. State 5. for Tobacco Inspection Loan.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Shore pay to the order of Amalia Jane Runsey, daughter of Henry C, seventeen dollars and fifty Cents for one quarters interest due this day, on \$1400. State 5. for Tobacco Inspection Loan.
