Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and trans-
mitted to the Executive Department of this State by His Excellency, George
Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain William Sharp
Wilson, and Miles Brown, (alias) Goodinham, are charged on each, the
first, with the crimes of Burglary and Larceny, and the latter with
Robbery, and that the said William Sharp Wilson, and Miles Brown
(alias) Goodinham, have fled from the justice of the said State, and
are now in the jail of Baltimore County.

And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid,
hath impetrated of the authority given in such cases, by the Constitution
and laws of the United States, demands the said William Sharp, Wil-
son, and Miles Brown, (alias) Goodinham, of the Executive of this
State, as fugitives from justice, and appoints Adam Bane his agent
to receive the said fugitives, and transport them to the said State
of Pennsylvania, for trial for the said offences;

Now therefore I, Daniel Martin Governor of the
State of Maryland, have thought proper in compliance with the
said demands, to order and direct, the surrender of the said fugi-
tives; and do hereby order and direct, the surrender of the said fugi-
tives; and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith deliver the
said William Sharp Wilson and Miles Brown, (alias) Goodinham, if
they are found in your bailiwick to the said Adam Bane agent as
aforesaid; he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and
detention of the said fugitives; for all which this shall be your suf-
ficient Warrant.
