Montpelier January 31 1831.

Gentlemen of the Senate, and
of the House of Delegates,

We have the honor to lay before you Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of Vermont, disapproving of the respective alterations proposed to be made in the Constitution of the United States, relative to the Election of President and Vice President, by the States of Georgia and Louisiana.
